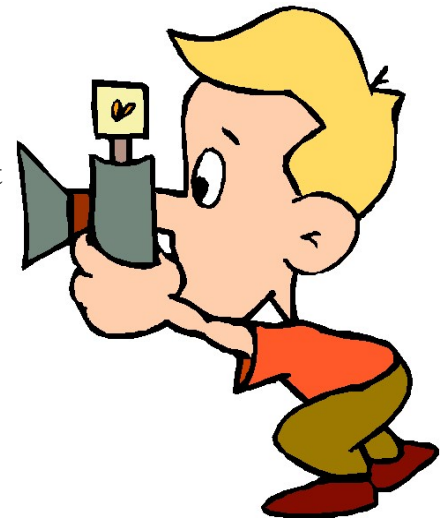

## Individual Pictures

Individual Picture will be taken on Thursday, November 19th beginning at 8:30am. Students, who will be photographed, may dress out of uniform for the day. Our 8th Grade students will be photographed only in the Cap & Gown for Graduation.

## Class Pictures

Class Pictures will be taken on Friday, November 20th beginning at 8:30am for students in Grades 1 to 8 and 9:15am for Early Childhood students.

All students will be photographed in the class picture unless you have informed the office, in writing, that you do not want your child in the class photo. Class photos will be published in the school yearbook.

### Students in Grades 1 to 8

Following Morning Prayer and Pledge, students in grades 1 to 8 will remain in Campbell Hall for the class pictures. Grade 1 to 8 class pictures will be completed by 9:00am. Unfortunately, any student arriving late to school may not be in the class picture.

**Students in grades 1 to 8 are to wear the complete winter uniform including the school sweater or fleece.** Students who arrive to school dressed inappropriately for the class picture may not be able to be included in the photo.

### Early Childhood Students
