The September payment is due by the 16th and the June payment is due on the 1st of June.

The cost for this program is \$125.00 per child, or \$200.00 per family.

Immunizations & Physicals

Students entering Kindergarten should have their second MMR and students entering Grade 6 should have their Tdap. All students must have a current physical on file in the school. Please have your pediatrician complete the Department of Health form distributed with the final report card and return it to school in September. Remember, the Department of Health requires these physicals and immunization and a student will be suspended from classes in September if documentation is not complete. If you should need an additional Department of Health medical form please call the school office.



Breakfast Served Daily

Breakfast is served each morning at 7:30am.

Grades 1 to 8

Students in Grades 1 to 8 must enter Campbell Hall from 51st Street and must arrive no later than 7:45am.



If you would like for your child to participate in the Breakfast program simply drop us a note or call the school office.

Students arriving to school prior to official drop-off time must be enrolled in the Breakfast Program.

Early Childhood

Early Childhood students enrolled in the Breakfast program may enter Campbell Hall from 7:30am to 7:45am.

Beginning at 7:45 am, Early Childhood students enrolled in the Breakfast program must enter Campbell Hall from the main entrance of the school on 52nd Street.


Breakfast is served until 8:00am. Students enrolled in the Breakfast program arriving after 8:00am will be able to remain with the group, but will not be able to eat breakfast.

Morning Drop Off in Campbell Hall

Students in Grades 1 to 8 are reminded to be in Campbell Hall by 8:15am to begin the school day with Morning Prayer, the Pledge of Allegiance and morning announcements. Students arriving after the start of Morning Prayer are considered tardy and will be issued a late pass.

Although the teachers are present in Campbell Hall during gathering time, parents are reminded that teachers are present to gather the students and prepare for the opening of the school day. If you would like to speak with a teacher regarding your child, please contact the school office or send an email to the classroom teacher.

Parents who wish to join us for Morning Prayer are welcome to do so, however, we ask that parents remain separate from the students and near the back of Campbell Hall adjacent to the Kitchen serving area. Parents staying for prayer are asked to enter Campbell Hall and immediately proceed to the designated area for Morning Prayer. At the end of Morning Prayer, parents are asked to exit Campbell Hall through 51st and not through the school building.



“I don’t feel well”

These are the last words that moms and dads want to hear in the morning before leaving for school. If your child is not feeling well, it is best that he or she remain at home that day. When a student comes to school sick, other students and the teacher can become sick too. Once you have decided to keep your child home, please call the school to let us know. A child’s absence must be reported by 9:00am each day. If your child is out sick for three or more days, you will need to bring a doctor’s note upon return to school. Also, we ask that if a student needs to be picked up during the school day due to illness, that every effort be made to come to the school as quickly as possible.
