### C & E Lockbox Reminder

Monthly tuition payments must be made according to your individual family contract with C&E Lockbox. Late fees will be assessed by C&E Lockbox when payments are received after the due date.

C&E Lockbox suggests mailing payments a minimum of 10 business days before the due date. We suggest that families consider the auto-debit payment method to avoid unnecessary delays that can be caused by using the coupon method.

Please remember, that late fees charged by C&E Lockbox are not reversible and must be paid in order for the account to be considered current. Even if there is a \$1.00 balance on the account, C&E Lockbox will charge the account the \$30.00 late fee.

## Morning Drop-Off for Grades 1 to 8

Parents are asked to observe the 8:00am drop-off time. Students are to enter the building beginning at 8:00am and must be in Campbell Hall ready to begin the day at 8:15am, so that we may begin Morning Prayer, Pledge and Daily Announcements. At the conclu-



sion of Morning Prayer, students will be escorted to the classrooms by the teachers. Parents are asked not to accompany students to the classrooms following Morning Prayer

and to exit Campbell Hall through the 51st Street exit.

Parents are asked to remain in the designated area at the rear of Campbell Hall and are also asked to refrain from interacting with their children and the teachers once prayer has begun.

Students arriving after 8:15am must enter from the main entrance on 52nd Street and receive a late pass from the school office.

We are firm in using the beginning of Morning Prayer as a school-wide means of determining tardiness. We realize that many families are traveling from a distance, and we understand that sometimes students will be late due to traffic or weather; however, we need a universal means of determining tardiness.

Remember that students who are tardy more than three times will not be eligible to receive honors. It is important to arrive on time and to begin the school day together.
